SUDEEPTI SHARMA J.

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 11.02.2016 passed by Division Bench of this Court in CWP-10374-1995.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he made a statement before this Court on 22.11.2023 that he will move clarification application before the Delhi High Court regarding the amount which was stayed by Delhi High Court. Subsequently, he moved the application before Delhi High Court but since the matters are pending before Hon'ble the Supreme Court, therefore, Delhi High Court adjourned sine die the application moved by the petitioner

3. In view of the same, the present contempt petition is **dismissed** at this stage. Liberty is however granted to the petitioner to avail the remedy as is available to her, in accordance with law after decision of Hon'ble the Supreme Court or Delhi High Court, whichever is earlier.
