1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent nos.1 & 2 for conducting fair and impartial investigation in the case FIR No.24 dated 08.03.2025, registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS, 2023 (Sections 117(2) & 118(2) of the BNS, 2023 added lateron), at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the complainant, who got the aforesaid FIR lodged on 08.03.2025 but the investigation in the aforesaid FIR is not making any headway due to unwanted political pressure upon the police officers/officials and even some of the accused are not being arrested despite the fact that they have specifically been named in the FIR.

3. Notice to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits, on instructions from SI Daljeet Singh, that the investigation is underway and would be concluded very soon as an enquiry is being conducted on the application made by one of the accused.

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5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to the official respondents to conclude the investigation in the aforesaid FIR expeditiously, in accordance with law.
