1. This case pertains to the year 2001 and falls in the category of old cases.
2. Despite notice issued to learned counsel for the appellant, no one has been putting in appearance on behalf of appellant since 29.08.2024.
3. As per instructions of learned State Counsel and report of Registry, the appellant has already retired and reported to have expired on 19.05.2021.
4. No application for bringing on record legal representatives of the appellant has been filed.
5. In these circumstances, this Court is left with no other option but to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution.
6. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution.
7. However, liberty is reserved to the legal representatives of appellant to move an application to revive the appeal in case any cause of action survives.
