1. The present petition has been filed for grant of permission to the petitioner for one day i.e. 02.04.2025 to attend the bhog ceremony of his father, who died on 24.03.2025, in case FIR No.135 dated 04.08.2021 under Sections 307, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

In compliance of order dated 01.04.2025, learned State counsel has, on instructions from Inspector Gaurav Dhir, SHO City Phagwara, verified the authenticity of the submissions made by the counsel opposite on the said date qua the demise of the father of the petitioner and his bhog ceremony to be held today i.e. on 02.04.2025 between 12:30 P.M. and 01:30 P.M. at Gurudwara Singh Sabha, Model Town, Phagwara.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of and the petitioner shall be taken to participate in the bhog ceremony of his departed father in police custody to the venue of bhog ceremony i.e. Gurudwara Singh Sabha, Model Town, Phagwara, today at 11:00 A.M. and would be escorted back to the jail where he is presently lodged, today itself by 05:00 P.M. All travel expenses incurred by the authorities concerned, shall be borne by the petitioner.
