The prayer in this petition under Section 483 BNSS, 2023 is for the grant of regular bail in case FIR No.135 dated 05.06.2024 registered under Sections 419, 420, 406, 120-B, 465, 467, 471 IPC at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a settlement has been arrived at between the parties as is evident from the compromise deed dated 08.08.2025 (Annexure A-1). As the petitioner is in custody for the last almost one year, he be granted the concession of bail.

3. The learned counsel for the State on the other hand, contends that the petitioner is a habitual offender with multiple other cases registered against him. Therefore, the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of bail.

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He, however, admits the factum of a compromise as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner who is incarcerated since 21.11.2024.

4. The learned counsel for the complainant admits the factum of a compromise and states that the complainant has no objection, if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. Admittedly, the petitioner is in custody since 21.11.2024. A compromise dated 08.08.2025 (Annexure A-1) has been effected between the parties and the complainant has admitted the same.

7. In view of the above, the present petitioner is allowed and the petitioner-Bikramjit Singh @ Vicky S/o Joginder Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
