At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts her prayer to the extent to which prayer has been made to give direction to the official respondents to decide the application dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-8) as filed by her raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon.
