JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 06.06.2005 (Annexure P-7) whereby petitioner was denied post of Havaldar Instructor.

2. The petitioner joined respondent on 04.11.1985 as member of Home Guard. He applied for the promotional post of Havaldar Instructor. The respondent rejected his claim on the ground of his ineligibility. He preferred instant petition before this Court. During the pendency of present petition, as per reply filed by State, the petitioner has been promoted to the post of Havaldar Clerk w.e.f. 12.10.2012. The pay scale of Havaldar Instructor was Rs.5200-20200+2400 Grade Pay

whereas pay scale of Havaladar Clerk was Rs.9300-34800+3200 Grade Pay, meaning thereby, petitioner has been assigned higher post and higher pay scale.

3. In the wake of development which has taken place during the pendency of instant petition, the petition stands ***disposed of***.

4. At this stage, Mr. A.P. Bhandari, Advocate submits that he may be granted liberty to move an appropriate application, if cause survives.

5. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
