1. Present contempt petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and under Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 07.02.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that in pursuance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the compliance report by way of affidavit dated 29.07.2024 has been submitted along with the speaking order dated 25.07.2024 which has been annexed as Annexure R-1 with the said affidavit and as per the same, after considering the case of the petitioner, it has been found that the
