Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying for quashing of FIR No.779 dated 01.10.2017 (P-1), under Sections 186, 323, 332, 341 and 353 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 21.07.2018 (P-2), arrived at between the parties.
