By way of the present petition, the petitioner, Sanjiv Kumar, has assailed the order dated 05.03.2025 passed by the learned Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khanna, whereby the application filed under Section 348 of the BNSS (corresponding to Section 311 Cr.P.C.) and Section 94 of the BNSS (corresponding to Section 91 Cr.P.C.) was dismissed.
