1. At the oral request of the petitioner, who is appearing in person, the names of respondent Nos.2 to 5 are ordered to be deleted from the array of the respondents. The requisite correction be made in the memo of parties by the Registry of this Court.

2. The matter is heard at length.

3. Since it is assured by Mr. B.S. Rana, the learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, that in case the present petitioner adequately responds to the show cause notice, thereupons, justice would be done to him. Resultantly, this Court believes



the assurance given to this Court by the learned senior counsel for the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, and also therebys, the petitioner, who is appearing in person, is permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition.

The respondent concerned is directed to provide a full hearing to the present petitioner, in the proceedings drawn against him, besides is also directed to ensure that the allegations of bias, victimisation and *mala fides*, rather ingraining the show cause notice are completely looked into and if the said allegations are proven, therebys such action, as deemed fit in accordance with law, be drawn against the errants concerned.
