Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner along with his family is residing in the same vicinity with respondents No. 4 to 7 and respondent No. 4 is deliberately harassing the petitioner and his family by filing false applications and creating nuisance in the society. Further respondent No. 4 has been using abusive language with the petitioner's wife and his daughter and wife and children of the petitioner are always afraid of private respondents. Petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No. 2 in this regard, but no action has been taken on it so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

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Notice of motion qua official respondents only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. AG Punjab, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel today itself.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in view of the submissions made therein, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
