The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a writ, order in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the appointment of a Warrant Officer to produce/release of detainee namely, Simran Mishra from the illegal custody of respondent No.5.

The learned State counsel submits that on an investigation conducted, it has been found that detainee namely, Simran Mishra the daughter of the petitioner is not in the illegal custody of respondent No.5. However, an FIR No.48 dated 16.03.2025 U/s 127(6) of BNS, 2023, P.S. Moti Nagar, Ludhiana already stands registered at the instance of the petitioner against unknown persons.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the Investigating Agency to proceed in accordance with law.
