MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J.

1. The instant petition is the second petition filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.439 dated 27.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) under Sections 318(4), 336(3), 338, 340 and 61 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Hisar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to bring to the notice of this Court any material change in circumstances after the dismissal of the previous petition on merits by this Court vide order 18.12.2024, which would warrant entertaining the instant petition.
3. Hence, no ground is made out to accept the prayer made in the instant petition to extend the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
