1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.25 dated 03.02.2025, registered under Sections 406, 420 of IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, at Police Station Mataur, District Mohali.
2. Vide order dated 04.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that the petitioner has joined investigation on 28.04.2025 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.
4. Keeping in view of the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 04.04.2025, granting interim bail to



the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
