JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. At the outset, Mr. G.S. Bhullar, learned AAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh submitted that in the present FIR, cancellation report has been prepared qua the petitioner and she stands exonerated by the police. He further submitted that he has instructions to state that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

2. In view of the stand taken by learned State Counsel, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that in case in future the petitioner is required to join investigation, then she shall join the same and shall also co-operate fully with the investigation process. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on her furnishing of personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer and she shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) BNSS.
