The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.386 dated 21.09.2023, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Central Faridabad, Haryana.
