SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No. 2 & 3 to provide adequate security and protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners who apprehend threat to their life from respondents No. 4 to 7 and not to interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners and not to intrude into the privacy of the petitioners by raiding their house time and again.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Devender Singh, SHO, Vairoka submits that representation dated 28.03.2025 is

being interrogated and during the investigation, the statement of Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Chak Arniwala got recorded, but the house/address mentioned in the Memo of Parties was found locked and both the petitioners are untraceable.

He, however, assures that necessary steps would be taken to decide the representation dated 28.03.2025 within one week thereafter.

In light of the above statement, nothing survives in the present petition and in case the petitioners are yet aggrieved, they shall come present before the Enquiry Officer on 04.04.2025 at 10:00 AM in person and their grievance can be addressed as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).

Petition is disposed of.
