1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to provide protection to life and liberty of petitioner and not to harass the petitioner by calling him in the police station at the instance of respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Perusal of various orders passed by this Court shows that petitioner is unrepresented since 25.07.2019. Thereafter, case was adjourned twice but no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and fresh notice was issued to the petitioner, which was received back with the report that petitioner has left the given address two years ago.

3. Today, also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

4. Learned Additional PP UT Chandigarh submits that nothing survives in the present petition. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking protection to his life and liberty on the ground that jurisdictional police authorities are calling him at the instance of respondents No. 4 and 5.

5. Learned Additional PP UT Chandigarh refers to the short reply

dated 21.11.2022 and submits that petitioner was called in connection with the complaint given by respondent No. 5 and after thorough examination of veracity of the allegations, nothing incriminating was found against the petitioner and public window application status of the complainant is attached with the short reply as Annexure R-1 and no cause of action survives in the present case. The representation of the petitioner has been considered and the same has been decided in accordance with law.

6. In view of the short reply filed on behalf of UT Chandigarh, present petition is disposed of as no further directions are required to be issued in the same.
