By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allot a residential plot under the 'Oustees Quota' to the petitioner, as per the advertisement dated 03.09.2018 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already made a representation dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-12) to respondent Nos. 3 and 4 for

redressal of his grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with his concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said representation.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana and Ms. Saanvi Singla Advocate, for respondent Nos. 2 to 4 are present in Court. Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 2 to 4 submits that the said representation shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurgaon (competent authority), to look into the pending representation dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-12) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
