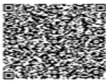

JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to reinstate him w.e.f. October' 2022.

2. The petitioners were relieved in October' 2022. They were working with HAFED-respondent No.3 through HKRNL on contract basis. They have filed instant petition for reinstatement. They were relieved in October' 2022. They were contractual employees.

3. Mr. Prince Singh, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that Kuldeep Singh-petitioner No.1 is working with respondent through outsource agency for the last 2 months. Thus, his grievance is not sustainable.



4. Without commenting on merit, instant petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner No.2 to approach HKRNL for his deployment in accordance with law.
