Petitioner has come up raising up an issue which is more than one decade old without reasonably and satisfactorily explaining the cause of such delayed approach. He also approached the Ombudsman in this regard, who has considered the grievance of the petitioner vide the Inquiry Report dated 24.08.2024 (Annexure P-28) and held that the any



action at such a belated stage is barred under Section 53 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994.

In view of the above, no case for interference is made out because of delay and laches. Hence, petition is dismissed.
