1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.21 dated 31.01.2025, registered under Sections 117(2), 109, 115(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS 2023 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.
2. Status report dated 22.04.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof, has been supplied to counsel opposite.
3. Vide order dated 06.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that the petitioner has joined investigation on 27.07.2025 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.



5. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.05.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
