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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner essentially being aggrieved by non-compliance of the directions contained in the order dated 21.07.2022 passed by Apex Court in Civil Appeal No. 10294 of 2013.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner by referring to an order dated 12.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) contends that despite issuance of the said order dated 12.07.2024 in compliance of the order of the Apex Court dated 21.07.2022, no steps have been taken for complete compliance.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has referred to an order dated 17.04.2025 passed by the Apex Court in Miscellaneous Application No. 41 of 2024 in C.A. No. 10294 of 2013 titled *Narinder Singh Vs Divesh*

Bhutani, whereby time for compliance of the order dated 21.07.2022 passed by the Apex Court has been extended till 31.07.2025. The Apex Court has also directed the State of Haryana to file compliance report within 1st week of August, 2025 with a copy to CEC who has been directed to examine the extent of compliance and submit a report before the Apex Court by the end of August, 2025.

4. In view of the above, since the matter for compliance of the orders is seized with the Apex Court, this Court declines interference and disposes of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to revisit this Court in case no compliance takes place even after of the orders of the Apex Court.
