1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, for quashing of FIR No.41 dated 10.02.2025 under Sections 3(5), 308(3), 309(4), 324(4) and 351(2) of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Sector 65, Gurugram, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1) with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom as per compromise dated 29.03.2025 (P-2) and affidavit dated 29.03.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. This Court vide order dated 07.04.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Gurugram and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned



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Magistrate has submitted copy of report dated 17.06.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed, and FIR No.41 dated 10.02.2025 under Sections 3(5), 308(3), 309(4), 324(4) and 351(2) of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Sector 65, Gurugram, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise dated 29.03.2025 (P-2) and affidavit dated 29.03.2025 (Annexure P-3).

7. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
