This is an application for placing on record the reply dated 17.05.2025 on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

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The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to conduct police verification for the purpose of issuance of passport to the petitioner without considering the
