1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus specially roving directing respondents No.2 and 3 to recover and produce detenue Riza who has been illegally abducted by the private respondent and now the detenue is in illegal custody of private respondent No.4.

2. Notice was issued and the State was directed to file the status report.

3. Detenue Riza is present in Court. The Court has interacted with her and she has stated before this Court that she is 20 years of age and has performed marriage with Ranjan respondent No.4, who is also present in Court. It has been submitted that after marriage both the detenue and respondent No.4 are living together in Basai, Gurugram and the allegations made by the petitioner regarding illegal confinement etc. of the detenue are false and frivolous.

4. However, learned counsel for the petitioner has opposed the same.

5. Needless to say that the present petition has been filed for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus. The detenue is present in Court and has submitted that she is of the age of majority and she has voluntarily married with

respondent No.4. Thus, in view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as such. However, the petitioner is at liberty to pursue her remedy in case any further cause of action accrues to her.
