1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to count his daily wage service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

2. The petitioner claims that respondent has not counted his daily wage service for the purpose of pensionary benefits. He joined respondent in 1982 and was regularized in 1993. The period of service from 1982-93 needs to be counted for pensionary benefits.
