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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner merely based on an apprehension that by orders dated 17.02.2025 (Annexure P-7) and 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-8), which are mere directions issued by the concerned revenue authorities to carry out demarcation of the property of the petitioner, petitioner may suffer demolition of his house. The petitioner has cited examples of other incidents which have taken place in recent past in various Districts of the State of Punjab.

2. After having gone through the petition and having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition appears to be merely based on apprehension where there is no cogent material which may reflect that the said apprehension is likely to turn into reality in the near future.

3. A direction for demarcation alone does not tantamount to any adverse effect upon the person concerned.

4. However, the petitioner is free to assail the order of demarcation under the Provincial Revenue Laws in accordance with law.
5. With the aforesaid observation, the petition stands disposed of.
