1. This is second petition that has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.114, dated 05.10.2024, under Sections 306, 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Division No.3, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

2. In compliance of order dated 07.04.2025, status report by way of affidavit dated 20.04.2025 of Aatish Bhatia, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, on behalf of respondent-State, has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.
