1. Instant Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 08.04.2025, the following order was passed: -

“Learned State counsel seeks adjournment to get instructions as to whether any action on the representation dated 31.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) has been taken or not.

Adjourned to 21.4.2025.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, submits that representation dated 31.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) has been received by respondent No.4 on 10.04.2025 and the same has been marked to the concerned investigating officer, namely, ASI Gurnam Singh (M. No.7888994152), who visited the residence of the



petitioner as mentioned in the writ petition, however, she was not found at the said address and statements of the neighbours and M.C. Counsellor were recorded to that effect. He further submits that if the petitioner approaches respondent No.4 and ASI Gurnam Singh, I.O., grievance raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 31.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) shall be considered and addressed.

4. Let the petitioner approach respondent No.4 or concerned I.O., ASI Gurnam Singh, within a period of one week from today and her representation dated 31.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) shall be disposed of within a period of one week thereafter.
