1. Prayer in this petition is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 18.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No. 6495 of 2024 titled as "*Parminder Kaur versus State of Punjab and others*".
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner has been accepted and revised pension pay order (Annexure R-1) has also been issued in favour of the petitioner. In this regard learned counsel for the respondent filed a compliance report dated 18.05.2025 by way of filing an affidavit of Sh. Ashish Sharma, Senior Executive Engineer (Electrical), PSPCL, which is taken on record.
