1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNSS') seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to take action on their representation/complaint dated 14.11.2024 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation/complaint on 14.11.2024 before the SHO, Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-1) raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.



4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation/complainant dated 14.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
