1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondent No. 6 by considering his grievances as raised in the representation dated 10.02.2025 (Annexure P-5), which has been submitted by him to respondent No. 4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga.

2. At the very outset, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has submitted that the dispute is purely of civil nature and the aforesaid representation, moved by the petitioner, has been filed after conducting a thorough inquiry into the matter. Hence, the dismissal of the petition is prayed for.

3. Faced with the same, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a direction may be issued to the official respondents to protect

the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family member at the hands of respondent No. 6.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts as well as the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of. The official respondents are directed to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members and provide them adequate protection, if so required.
