The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.41 dated 08.02.2025, registered under Sections 21-C, 25, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Anti Narcotics Force, District ANTF Wing at Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
