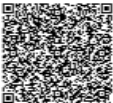

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioners to move an appropriate application under Section 119(2)(b) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, seeking condonation of delay in filing the Income Tax Returns, in the first instance. Particularly, for prior to the institution of this petition, the petitioners had even submitted a representation to the respondent-authorities on December 12, 2024 (P-5), which is pending consideration.

Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Saurabh Kapoor, learned Senior Standing Counsel, is present in Court on behalf of the respondent(s). As always, he fairly submits that if the petitioners move any such application, the same shall be considered and dealt with by the competent authority. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed thereon, at the earliest.
