1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India are seeking directions to respondent to grant them seniority, pay fixation and consequential benefits on notional basis.

2. The petitioners pursuant to advertisement of 2010 applied for the post of Constable. Final result was declared in 2011, however, they were permitted to join in 2013-14.

3. Mr. J.S. Mohri submits that petitioners are entitled to seniority, pay fixation and consequential benefits on notional basis from the date their colleagues joined pursuant to advertisement of 2010.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that competent authority would consider representation of petitioners and pass an appropriate order within 06 months from today, after granting them opportunity of hearing.

5. Mr. J.S. Mohri agrees to the aforesaid statement.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of.

7. It is made clear that if petitioners are held entitled to seniority, pay fixation and consequential benefits on notional basis, they would not be entitled to arrears for the period from the date of joining of their colleagues to the date of filing petition before this Court.
