The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to grant pension to the petitioners under Old Pension Scheme i.e. as provided under Chapter II Vol. II of Punjab Civil Services Rules (as applicable to Haryana) for the purpose of Pension and Family Pension Rules, 1964.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Director General, State Transport Haryana is directed to decide the Legal Notice dated 12.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) and the grievance espoused

by the petitioner therein by passing a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-Director General, State Transport Haryana, is directed to decide the Legal Notice dated 12.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of two months.
