1. Instant writ petition has been filed *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to remove the illegal encroachment from the land of Vyas Kund in Tehsil Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. In the response filed on behalf of respondents No. 1, 2 and 4, it has been submitted that after a demarcation was conducted on 17.09.2020, Annexure P-3, a petition under Section 7(2) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 titled as ***Gram Panchayat Bilaspur Versus Government School Bilaspur*** bearing case No. 706/2022 has been filed and is pending before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade (DRO), Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.
