Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') praying to transfer the investigation of FIR No.11 dated 06.02.2024 (P-1), under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana to any other Police Officer.

2. This Court on 09.04.2025, passed the following order:-
