1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action on the complaint of the petitioner dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent No.4.
2. Learned State counsel refers to para Nos.6 and 7 of the status report filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and submits that the threat perception of the petitioner was dispassionately assessed and no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner has been found. Further, learned State counsel submits that the allegations levelled against respondent Nos.4 and 5 are totally misconceived as respondent No.4 i.e. ACP North has been transferred as ACP Traffic, Ludhiana, wayback in the year 2024 and respondent No.5, DIG, Vigilance Bureau has retired on June 30, 2024. As such, apprehension of the petitioner is fanciful and there is no real threat to his life and liberty.
3. In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed.
