Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.182, dated 26.11.2024, under Sections 325, 109, 317(2), 341(2) of BNS, 2023; Section 8 of Punjab Prohibition of Cow Slaughter Act, 1955; Section 11 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 07.04.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.04.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from quarter concerned, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



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In view of the above, interim order dated 07.04.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands allowed.
