1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner, who is apprehending danger at the behest of respondent nos.3 to 6.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that *de hors* the averments made in the present petition, the petitioner would be satisfied if the official respondents are directed to decide his representation dated 21.01.2025 (Annexure P-1).
3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.
5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide representation dated 21.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) and grant protection of life and liberty to the petitioner, if any threat to his life and liberty is perceived.
6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.
