1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a challenge is thrown to order/notice dated 14.07.2020 and 15.07.2020 (Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively), wherethrough, the request of the petitioner for extension to retain the government allotted quarter was declined, rather, he was directed to vacate the same within a week. Further, the request of the petitioner to retain the government quarter beyond the allotted period on account of outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic at that time, was also declined.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner informs this Court that the petitioner has already vacated the government quarter in question. Therefore, now the only issue which remains for consideration before this Court, is with regard to the imposition of penal rent upon the petitioner.

3. This Court finds that the order of imposition of penal rent has not been put to challenge before this Court, therefore, the said prayer as made through the instant petition, has already rendered infructuous.

4. Consequently, the instant petition is **disposed of**, accordingly. However, the case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the imposition of penal rent, he is at liberty to approach the authority concerned by filing a detailed representation.

5. In case, the petitioner moves such a representation, before the authority concerned, the same shall be decided, most expeditiously, after giving an adequate opportunity of hearing to him.

6. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed of** accordingly.
