Learned counsel for the parties agree that all the facts which have been pleaded by the respective parties to present their case have not been taken into account while passing the orders in favour of the respondent No.4-senior citizen so as to revert back the land in question i.e. 20 kanals 9 marlas at village Lehal Kalan which was given to the petitioner-daughter by the respondent No.4-senior citizen.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that he has no objection in case both the orders are set aside and the case is remanded back to the Tribunal for adjudication so as to pass appropriate order after considering the respective pleas taken by the parties concerned in their favour as to whether, the application filed by the respondent No.4-senior citizen requires acceptance or not.

3. Keeping in view the agreement between the parties, the impugned orders are set aside and the case is remanded back to the Tribunal
