KARAMJIT SINGH, J.(Oral)

1. Counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* submits that petitioner No.1 is a widow aged about 49 years and petitioner No.2 a divorcee aged about 52 years and they performed marriage on 11.03.2024 and the marriage certificate is Annexure P-1. It is further submitted that the private respondents No.4 to 8 have threatened to cause physical harm to both the petitioners and the matter is already reported to the police vide representation dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) but till date no action has been taken by the police authorities in this regard.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Inderjeet Singh Ladher, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and made statement that in case any such



representation given by the petitioners is still pending, the same will be looked into and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law, at the earliest.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and decide representation dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. .

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
