By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing clause No.5 and 6 of the allotment letter dated 16.11.2024 (Annexure P-24), thereby calling upon the petitioner to deposit an amount of Rs.2,79,43,380/- i.e. the current reserve price of the year 2024-2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of his grievance, the petitioner shall approach the competent authority by filing an appropriate representation.

Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, is present in Court for respondent No.1 and Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate for respondents No.2 to 4 and submit that if, any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate representation before the competent authority-respondent No.2 (The Chief Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran Sector-6, Panchkula). In case, any such representation is filed, the respondent No.2 shall look into the same and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of filing/receipt of such representation.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
