1. This Court, vide order dated 14.10.2025, had passed the hereinafter extracted order, upon the instant writ petition :-

“There is no representation on behalf of the parties, despite both the counsels, being informed by the Registry of this Court, through e-mail.

Let Court notice be issued to petitioner as well as respondents, returnable on 18.11.2025.”

2. As per report of the Registry, Mr. Devinder Singh Gurna, Advocate and Mr. Saravpreet Singh Cheema, Advocate, were informed through e-mail, and Court notice issued to the petitioner, received back with the report ‘*not residing at the given address*’.
