VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. Despite repeated opportunities, counsel for the appellant is unable to implead the LR's of deceased appellant. Since, today is last opportunity to implead the LR's and counsel for the appellant is unable to do the same, it seems that no one is ready to pursue the instant appeal.
2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.
3. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the appellant to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.
4. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands dismissed for want of prosecution, all pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them pending.
