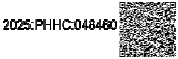
The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent/College to release the pending salary of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case second respondent is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 13.09.2023, Annexure P-6, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending representation, dated 13.09.2023, will be decided by the second respondent/Director General, Higher Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

- 7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
